"Fancy bling-bling nail art is not on trend right now. It's all about simple nail art that brings out the contrast of colour or texture differences – for instance, a matte and glossy dual texture, or reverse coloured half-moon manicures. It can be fun to play with dual contrasts using the super-metallic Minx effects too."

Try the bittersweet muted autumn colours of Sofisticato (a soft taupe), Khaki (camo green) and Smokey (a cloudy grey).

Trend: Shimmer and sparkle

As the founder of Hong Kong-based independent nail polish e-boutique Shop Dazzled, Denise Tam believes her customers' lust for glitter will continue throughout fall:

"Holographic nail polishes are currently all the rage for indie polish lovers... and long may this trend continue! Too Fancy Lacquer is a local indie brand that specialises in gorgeous holographic polishes; they created this special teal shade, Buried Treasures, exclusively for our monthly surprise Holo Grail Box, where all polishes remain a mystery until you receive them – a concept that's been a real best-seller.

Microglitters are another recent big trend – little glitters that sparkle like crazy but are much easier to remove than the chunky glitters of old. They can be layered over other colours with thin coats, used for mani gradients or as single accent nails to create a million different looks. I love French Roast, a creation from New York-based brand Cirque, which also hits another key colour of the season, bronze.

Trend: Long and defined

Sandra Grau, general manager of Flawless spa, sees eye-catching shapes as a big trend for fall:

"Call them talons, stiletto nails, claws, almond-shaped nails or simply pointy, the long and defined nail trend has been embraced by many celebrities and fashion runways. The talon shape elongates fingers and exudes sexy and tough. If you don't feel comfortable with long nails, try oval outlines on medium and short nails for a similar effect.

Meanwhile, the unconventional French manicure is back with vintage-looking nail art like half-half, half-moons and diagonally-split designs. Barely-there pinks and nudes, browns, hazy shades of blue, dusty teals, dark reds and dark polishes with metallic finishes are the notable nail hues of the season."
